

Hundreds cheer, sing, crowd onto Supreme Court steps

Washington (dpa) - Hundreds of gay rights activists crowd onto the normally forbidden steps of the US Supreme Court, bursting into song with the national anthem to celebrate the legalization of gay marriage.

Adam Boyd, 22, of Cheyenne, Wyoming, a member of the LGBT community, says he didn't think he would ever see this day come.

"I grew up in a very conservative town in Wyoming," Boyd tells dpa. "This was really a chance to see history be made and see that some change can actually happen in this country."

"I always wanted to get married, I always wanted to have a family," Boyd says. "Now I get to participate in this as an American."
